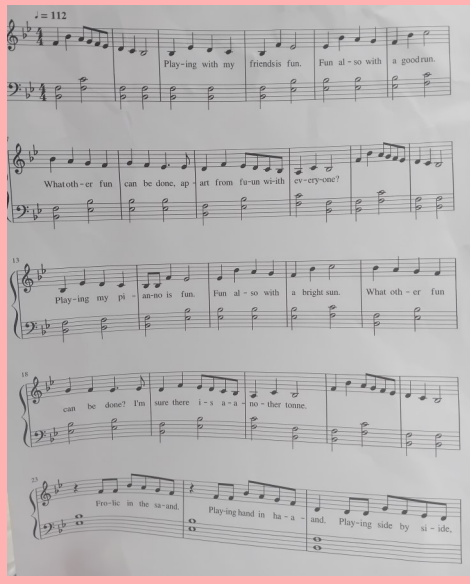
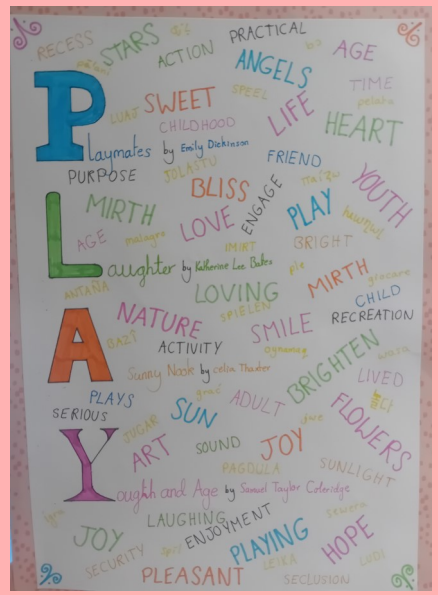


TCS Reading Newsletter: Term Two
