Read with Pride

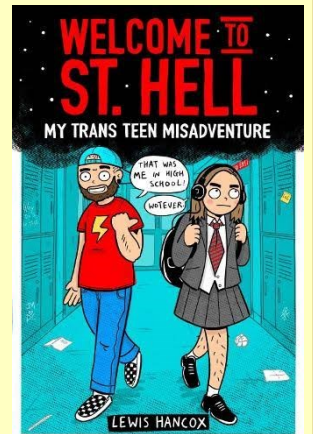
To celebrate Pride month, we encourage students to read with pride!

Visit the library to see more recommended reads.

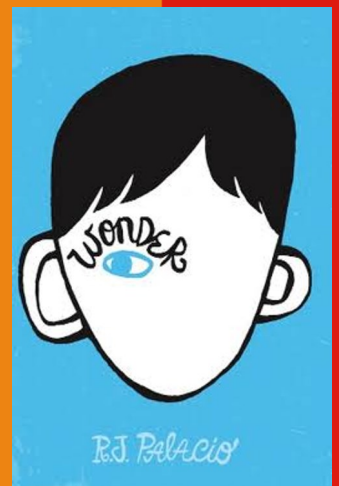


Sponsored Read: Book Vote
